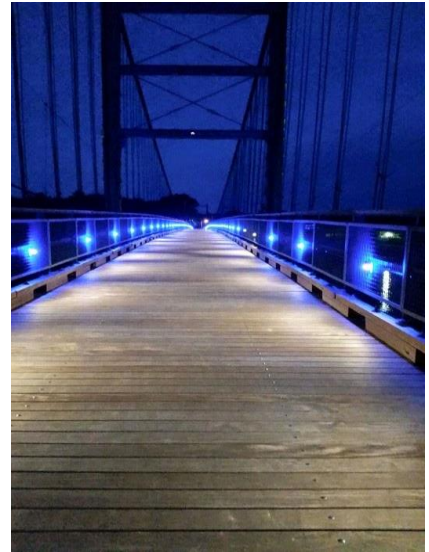


JOE DICE BRIDGE – WARSAW, MO

PROJECT PROFILE



Placed on the National Historic Register in 1999, the “Upper Bridge” is the last of 15 swing bridges that once crossed the Osage River linking the Great Lakes with the Gulf of Mexico.

Designed by Joe Dice, a self-taught engineer who never used a blue print the Upper Bridge Phase I renovations were completed in 2007.

Phase II renovations were completed in 2016 with the replacement of the failed Cypress decking installed in 2007 with Tropical Forest Products Cumaru Bridge Decking and a state of the art LED lighting system.
