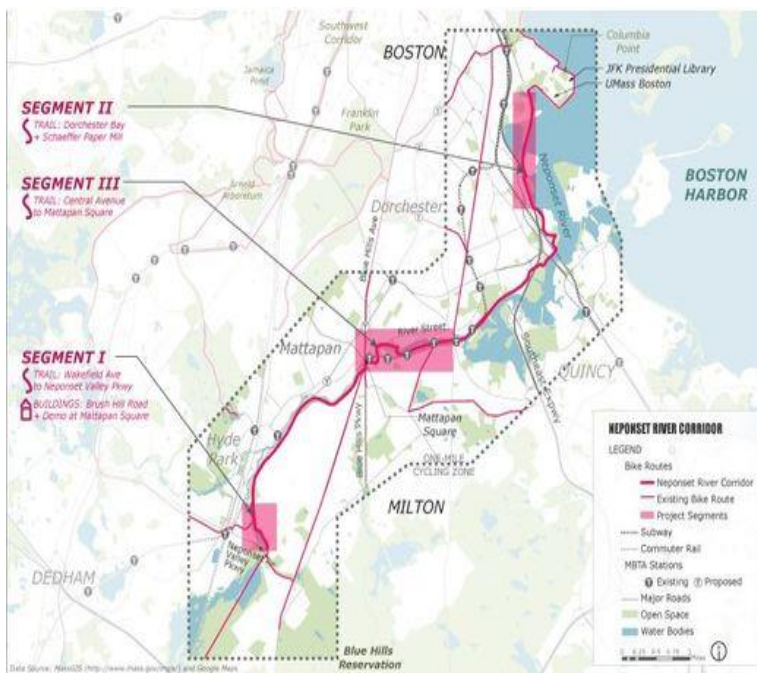


NEPONSET RIVER GREENWAY BRIDGE – BOSTON MA

PROJECT PROFILE



Description –

A new pedestrian bridge over the Neponset River will connect to Ryan Playground in Boston and an 1100-foot-long Canopy Walk will carry users through an existing mature oak grove over the rail line to Mattapan Station and Mattapan Square.

An extension of the Neponset River Master Plan, completed in 2007, the Neponset Greenway Corridor Completion Project will complete a bicycle and pedestrian route that links urban and suburban communities between Boston Harbor and the Blue Hills Reservation over 8 miles away. It expands upon a heavily used bicycle/pedestrian network in the Boston area, creating healthy transportation options and seamless connections between diverse communities and links to job centers, higher education institutions and recreational opportunities.
